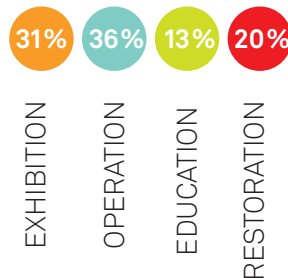
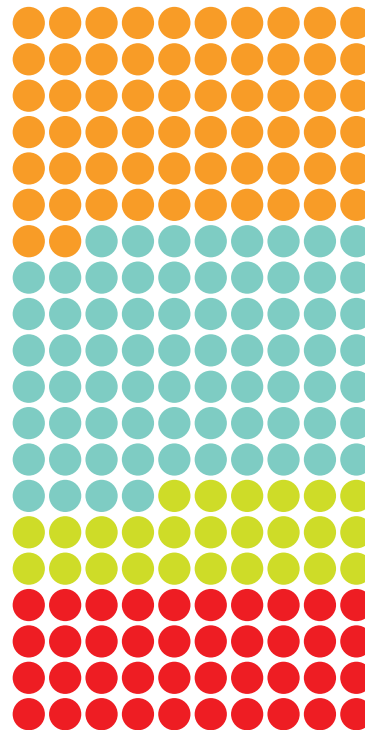
There is a story behind every one of the objects in our collection and our goal is to share it with our visitors.

- Celebrating the social history of Montreal, past and present, the McCord Museum is home to one of the largest historical collections in North America, organized into the following departments: Dress, Fashion and Textiles, Photography, Indigenous Cultures, Paintings, Prints and Drawings, Decorative Arts and Textual Archives
- The Museum's reserves contain 1.5 million objects, images and documents

● ROLLS UP OUR SLEEVES FOR YOU

Our dedicated team works to ensure that every visitor enjoys an enriching experience and leaves the Museum inspired by our activities and exhibitions.

- The Museum presents approximately twelve different exhibitions each year
- Every year, some 300,000 visitors come to the Museum to explore our history, our people and our communities
- Over 3,400 people take part in the cultural activities organized to complement our exhibitions



● UNRAVELS THE FABRIC OF KNOWLEDGE

We organize a number of activities that enable young and old to learn about the stories behind the history.

- More than 10,000 preschool, elementary and high school students take subsidized tours to help them become engaged citizens
- Throughout the year, over 5,700 members of the general public and community groups participate in thematic tours and different activities to gain a contemporary perspective on and better understand their history
- Some 7,500 people take part in family activities offered at the Museum

● TREATS OUR COLLECTION WITH KID GLOVES

To help the public fully appreciate our collection, both in our galleries and through the objects we loan to other institutions, we have to ensure that it is looking its best.

- In 2018-2019, the Museum restored 313 artefacts in order to preserve and share our history
- The Museum digitized 2,447 historical documents and objects last year, adding over 13,500 images to our accessible online database
- Every year, our Archives and Documentation Centre provides access to all of our collections to over 1,800 individuals and researchers
