

**Terms and conditions for the adoption campaign for the stuffed animals in the  
Ogilvy mechanical holiday window displays**

1.1 The adoption campaign is open to the public from November 12, 2019, to January 5, 2020.

1.2 Each stuffed animal or group of stuffed animals is unique and can be adopted only once during the adoption campaign.

1.3 The adoption is virtual: the stuffed animals remain in the window displays.

1.4 The adoption is valid for 4 years. As of November 12, 2023, the McCord Museum Foundation and the McCord Museum will be free to launch a new adoption campaign, should the occasion arise.

1.5 A tax receipt for the amount of the donation will be issued to the payer. This receipt will be sent as a PDF file by email to the payer's email address.

1.6 The McCord Museum Foundation will send the certificate of adoption by mail to the payer's postal address within several working days of the transaction.

1.8 For adoptions made after December 17, 2019, the tax receipt will be issued mid-January 2020.

1.9 The Museum and the Foundation are not responsible for delays in delivery linked to Canada Post. In case of a strike, it will be possible to pick up the certificate of adoption directly from the Museum. If you would like to do so, please contact the Foundation by email at [fondation-mccord@mccord-stewart.ca](mailto:fondation-mccord@mccord-stewart.ca) as soon as the transaction is completed, providing your name and the stuffed animal's description.

1.10 If the payer gives the certificate of adoption as a gift, the recipient can, if desired, contact the McCord Museum Foundation at [fondation-mccord@mccord-stewart.ca](mailto:fondation-mccord@mccord-stewart.ca) to request that his or her name and the stuffed animal's name appear on the McCord Museum website. This person must provide the stuffed animal's description and the payer's full name.

1.11 However, some names are prohibited on the McCord Museum website. The Foundation and the Museum reserve the right to suppress names that go against their values.
