The Museum also relies upon a solid network of collaborators, including exhibition professionals, suppliers, and research, creation, design and production experts. The incumbent will participate in the preparation, installation and maintenance of exhibitions, in collaboration with the Museum's exhibition team.

## Duties and responsibilities of the incumbent, under the supervision of the Chief Technician:

- Prepare, install, maintain and dismantle exhibitions and special projects
- Plan, design and produce mounts for all objects from the collection or loaned objects for exhibitions
- Build crates, pack objects and help with the transport of objects
- Install lighting and soundscapes for exhibitions and events
- Move collection objects, showcases and related equipment for exhibitions
- Provide technical assistance to other departments, if required

- Temporary position. 35 hours per week. Occasional work in evenings and on weekends
- Salary commensurate with experience

## Qualifications and profile required:

- A completed college degree as technician in Museum Studies
- 2 to 5 years relevant experience, including the use of workshop tools to work different materials (wood, plexi, metal, etc.)

- Ability to drive a light truck, an asset
